POLST - Physician Orders for Life Sustaining Treatment (POLST) became law in Hawaii on July 15, 2009 as Act 186.

Kokua Mau is the lead agency for implementation of POLST in Hawai'i.

We have created a <u>designated website for POLST</u> related information. You can download the "<u>POLST Form</u>" and the "Provider's Guide to POLST" as a pdf in one single location. The POLST form is free and please keep in mind that it should be printed two-sided on lime green paper. (<u>More about that on our website.</u>)

We are creating a "Consumer's Guide to POLST" that will be posted soon. If you would like to have a speaker about POLST, please contact our <u>speaker's bureau</u>.
